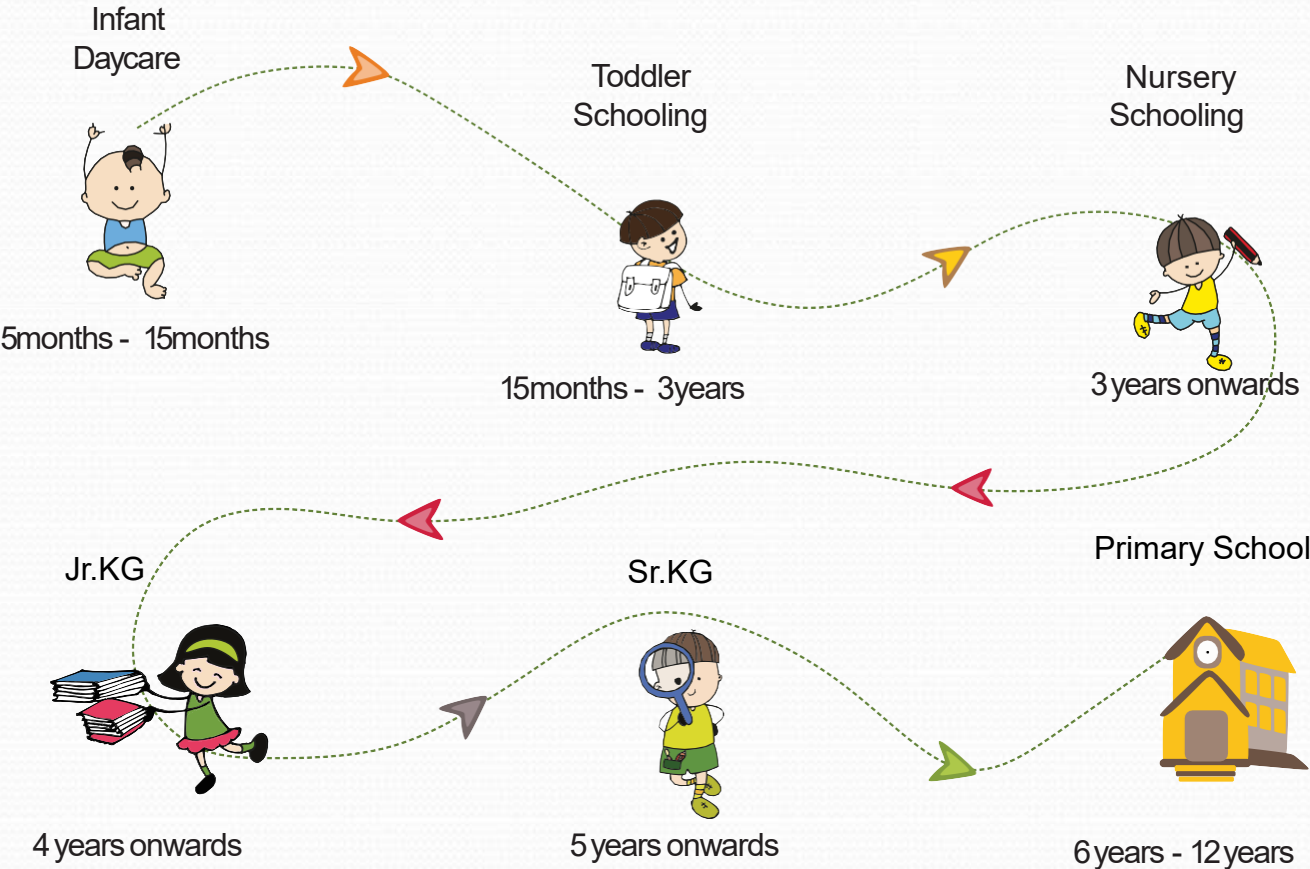

- Organizing safe transport



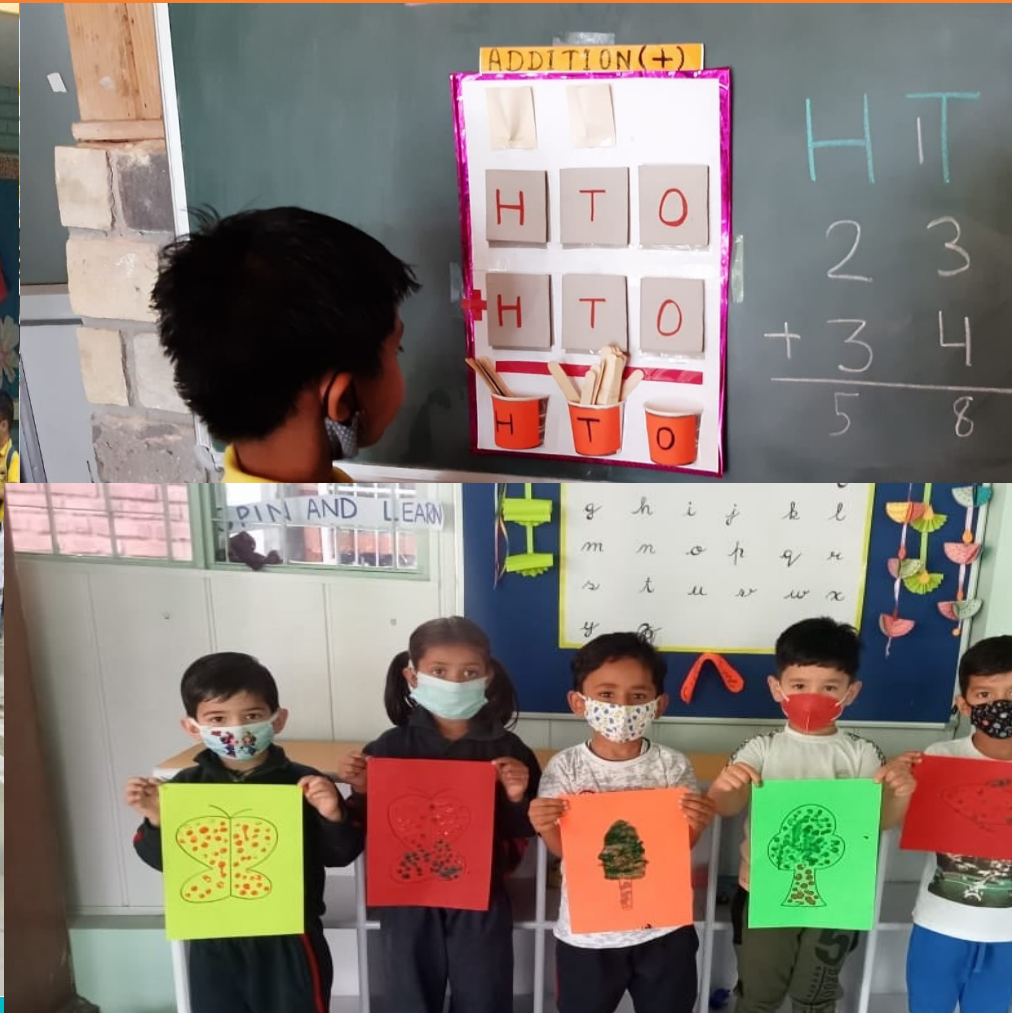
Physical Safety at SIS

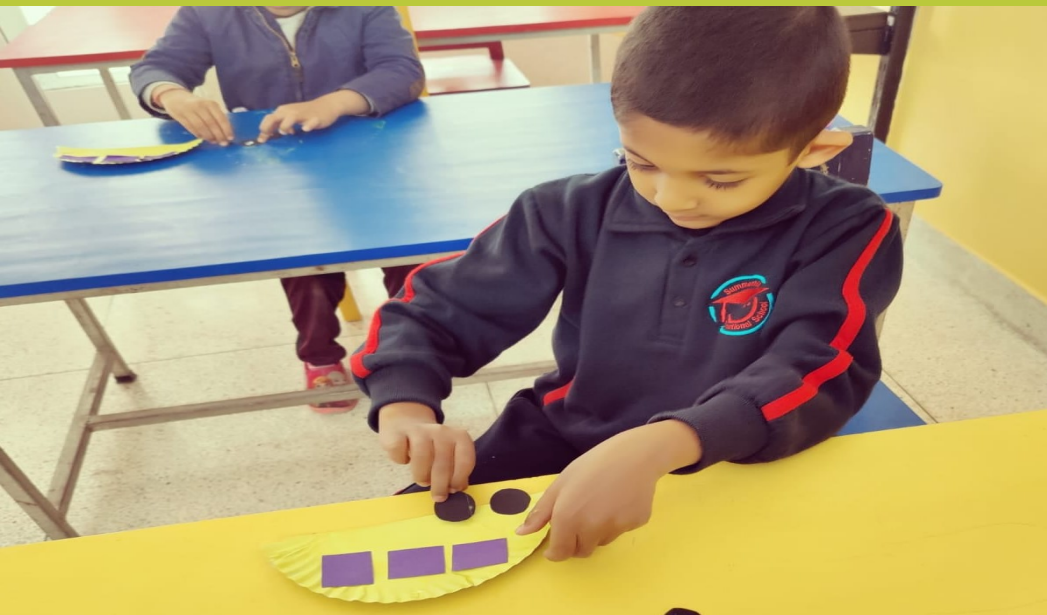
